**MINUTES**

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**PRESENT:** Jan Clanton, Francine Newberg, Tom McMacken, Nancy Daly, Keith Reeves and Anne Grey; Senior Planner Lindsey Hayes and Recording Secretary Marva Fortson.

**1. CALL TO ORDER**

Mrs. Clanton called the meeting of the Public Art Advisory Board to order at 12:35 p.m., Room 200 at City Hall, 401 Park Avenue South, Winter Park, Florida.

**2. ART ON THE GREEN**

**A. FIRST SATURDAYS, ART & MUSIC ON THE GREEN (February 3<sup>rd</sup>)**

Mrs. Clanton stated she will not be attending the February 3<sup>rd</sup> event due to previous engagements and volunteered Mrs. Newberg to replace her with the volunteers from Trinity, Gary Heindrich and Wendy St. Lawrence (catalog handouts, etc). Mrs. Clanton stated that Mrs. Segal will have Rollins musicians attending on February 3<sup>rd</sup> and not February 17<sup>th</sup>; Mrs. Segal is also talking with the Florida Youth Symphony of the event.

The Board expressed concern with the lights being out in the park and requested letter to be mailed to Steve Mathis and City Manager Jim Williams.

**B. PUBLIC ART FORUM AND RECEPTION (FEBRUARY 7<sup>TH</sup>)**

Mrs. Newberg stated Mr. Accoci will speak following the Orange County Proclamation to Mayor Strong and Billy Dingman, 5:30 p.m. at Rollins College; stating all invitations has been mailed and invited all Board members to attend the reception.

The Board discussed media and/or photographer from the City in attendance.

**C. CLOSING EVENT (FEBRUARY 17<sup>TH</sup>)**

Mrs. Grey stated that hot dogs would be provided from Uncle Andy's and a children's' art project from Crealde' School of Art. Catalogs will be available at the event.

Mrs. Newberg distributed information regarding the ad in the Calendar section in Sunday's paper (February 3<sup>rd</sup>). The Board discussed the media ad with the sponsor name (Volvo Store) and agreed to the following statement: "Art on the Green has been made possible by the City of Winter Park and presenting sponsor The Volvo Store."

**D. DISTRIBUTION OF PRINT MATERIALS**

The Board decided to pickup materials (catalogs) on Thursday, February 1<sup>st</sup> at 5:30 p.m.

**3. ART IN CHAMBERS**

The Board discussed the reception opening on Tuesday, March 13, 2007.

Ms. Hayes stated the contract/loan agreement for the Nevelson will continue through Monday, February 19<sup>th</sup> with the shipment being delivered back to Pace Wildenstein Gallery.

The Board discussed the contracts for the sculptures and their removal and return to the lenders. Mrs. Newberg gave an update of the budget.

Mrs. Daly stated she will have a follow-up with Rollins College which will be surveying the event on Saturday, February 2<sup>nd</sup>. Rollins College will also conduct a survey at the closing event and will complete a draft economic analysis report for the Board.

The Board discussed funds for the closing ceremony budget, repairs, the Orlando Sentinel Ad, a summary of the event to the City Commissioners and the Art on the Green survey.

The next meeting will be held Monday, February 26<sup>th</sup>, 12:30 p.m. in the Commission Chambers.
