**MINUTES**

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**PRESENT:** Jan Clanton, Francine Newberg, Anne Grey, Sara Segal, Nancy Daly, Louise Peterson, Tom McMacken, Joe Roviario and Susan Battaglia; Staff: Lindsey Hayes, Staff Liaison and Recording Secretary, Marva Fortson; Guest speaker, Peter Schreyer.

**I. CALL TO ORDER**

Mrs. Clanton called the meeting of the Public Art Advisory Board to order at 12:35 p.m. in the City Hall Commission Chambers, 401 Park Avenue South, Winter Park, Florida.

**II. NEW BUSINESS**

**A. INTRODUCTION OF NEW BOARD APPOINTEES**

Mrs. Clanton introduced new Board member, Joe Roviario. Mr. Roviario stated he has been a resident of Winter Park for fifteen years, has an undergraduate degree in Visual Arts Education and his interests are photography, traveling and sculpture.

The PAAB Board members introduced themselves to Mr. Roviario. Mrs. Clanton stated Charles Robbins and Leslie Hardy (new members) will not be present at the meeting.

**B. CHAIRPERSON NOMINATIONS FOR 2007 - 2008 TERMS**

Mrs. Clanton stated nominations for the 2007-2008 terms were Tom McMacken, Chairperson and Vice Chairperson, Francine Newberg.

Motion made by Mrs. Battaglia, seconded by Mrs. Peterson to approve the new nominees, Tom McMacken, Chairperson and Vice Chairperson, Francine Newberg for 2007-2008 term. Motion carried unanimously with a 9-0 vote.

Mr. McMacken thanked the Board for their nominations and gave recognition to Mrs. Clanton for her accomplishments and direction with the Public Arts Advisory Board. She thanked the Board for the gift that was presented to her.

Meeting minutes from April 23<sup>rd</sup> and May 29<sup>th</sup> were reviewed by the Board.

Motion made by Mrs. Daly, seconded by Mrs. Newberg to approve the April 23<sup>rd</sup> and May 29<sup>th</sup> meeting minutes as amended. Motion carried unanimously with a 9-0 vote.

**C. CREALDE / HERITAGE CENTER EXHIBITION WITH MR. IMAGINATION**

Mr. Schreyer gave an overview of a proposed project for the Winter Park community during the month of February 2008, Black History Month. He stated that early next year, the Heritage Center will present Mr. Imagination (Gregory Warmack), a folk artist for a one-person exhibition coinciding with African American History Month. The exhibit will be held on the Crealde School of Arts main campus and the new Hannibal Square Heritage Center; a "Memory Wall" (10-12 feet long) will be created in front of the Hannibal Square Heritage Center facing the parking lot. This will be an outdoor community sculpture of keepsakes, trinkets, etc. Mr. Schreyer is seeking input from the Public Arts Advisory Board. He stated that prior grant support has been received from schools, the City and the Crealde'. Mr. Scheyer answered questions from the Board.

The Board discussed the materials that are to be reviewed later: drawings, plans, photos, dimensions, installation method, materials, Parks & Recreation Department approval, and letter from sponsors and from Jeanine Taylor of Folk Art. In response to questioning, Mr. Schreyer stated that Crealde' would own the artwork and would be responsible for its care and maintenance.

**D. A DAY IN THE LIFE OF WINTER PARK, TRINITY PREPARATORY SCHOOL PROJECT**

Mrs. Grey gave an overview and presented information (booklets, framed photos, etc.) about the Day in the Life of Winter Park by Mr. Malles, a photographer and teacher at Trinity Preparatory School. There are ninety (90) framed black & exhibited at the Winter Park Village for two days (48-hours). She stated Mr. Malles will be attending the August 27<sup>th</sup> meeting for a follow-up discussion with the Board. Mrs. Grey answered questions from the Board.

The Board discussed the collection. The Board discussed the location of the art at the Welcome Center or as a presentation at the Popcorn Flicks; having a visual display projected onto a wall at night. The Board will have more information at the next meeting on August 27<sup>th</sup>.

**III. OLD BUSINESS**

**A. PAAB STRATEGIC PLANNING SESSION, WEDNESDAY, JUNE 27<sup>TH</sup>**

Mrs. Daly stated the PAAB Strategic Planning Session will be held at the Winter Park Golf Course Clubhouse, 8:00am - 4:00pm. Board members were asked to review the external scan and specific areas of the guidelines, funds and objectives (notebook, behind tab #2) for further discussion at the meeting.

Board members that will not be attending the Strategic Planning session are Anne Grey, Leslie Hardy, Charles Robbins and Joseph Roviario.

**IV. OTHER BUSINESS**

Mrs. Newberg questioned the lighting project in the Chamber, information from Chip Weston regarding art for the Welcome Center and the funds allocation. She stated that she would like to receive a follow-up since the funding process has started.

Ms. Hayes stated Steve Mathis of the Building Maintenance Department will be receiving an updated quote for the installation of lights as well as materials. She will review the remaining budget.

Mr. McMacken inquired about Mr. Weston attending the next PAAB meeting, August 27<sup>th</sup> giving more detailed information regarding the Welcome Center. He stated there was no new information about the Emily sculpture at this time other than the letter that was mailed to the Parks Department requesting the restoration to be approved.

**V. ADJOURNMENT**
