**MINUTES**

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**PRESENT:** Francine Newberg, Anne Gray, Sara Segal, Susan Battaglia, Nancy Daly; Staff: Lindsey Hayes, Staff Liaison and Recording Secretary, Marva Fortson.

**I. CALL TO ORDER**

Board Liaison, Lindsey Hayes called the May 29, 2007 meeting of the Public Art Advisory Board to order at 12:45 p.m. in the Commission Chambers at City Hall, 401 Park Avenue South, Winter Park, Florida. There was not a quorum at the meeting.

**II. NEW BUSINESS**

**A. A DAY IN THE LIFE OF WINTER PARK, TRINITY PREPARATORY SCHOOL PROJECT**

Mrs. Gray presented information about the A Day in the Life of Winter Park project by Ed Malles, which is shown every year. Mr. Malles is a photographer at Trinity Preparatory School assisting eighty (80) students. Mr. Malles could provide ninety (90) framed black/white and color individually framed art (11X12) of Winter Park selected from over 3500 photos available. This event is the 8<sup>th</sup> annual project and he has one exhibition. The Board suggested having the student's art in the Chamber, creating a book of the art, selling them at the Farmer's Market and/or during an event, creating posters of the art and having them laminating and/or coated. Mrs. Gray will see if she can arrange to bring some examples to the next meeting and they agreed that no recommendation would be made until more board members were present.

Ms. Hayes reported speaking with Steve Mathis of the Building Maintenance Department regarding the lighting installation. The quote was \$1,298.00 for materials only; she stated that at this time there is a technical issue but that funds are available in the PAAB budget. She expects to have more details at the next meeting. A letter was sent to John Holland of the Parks Board by Tom McMacken regarding the Emily sculpture in Central Park.

**B. PAAB STRATEGIC PLANNING SESSION UPDATE**

The Board will meet Friday, June 1<sup>st</sup>, 1:30pm to discuss more in detail the scope of the Strategic Planning Workshop on Wednesday, June 27<sup>th</sup>.

**C. CHAIRPERSON NOMINATIONS FOR 2007 - 2008 TERM**

Ms. Hayes stated that Jan Clanton's term as Chairperson will be expiring next month and the Board will have to select a new Board Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson. Mrs. Finnegan will contact eligible Board members who may be willing to serve if selected.
