The City of Winter Park and Waste Pro® have single stream recycling, which means all recyclables may be placed together loosely in the same bin. The items below are the expanded acceptable recyclables.

Acceptable Recyclables

- Aluminum foil
- Aseptic packaging - drink boxes, milk & juice cartons
- Bottles - brown, clear & green
- Brown paper bags
- Cans - aerosol, aluminum, steel & tin
- Cartons - beer, egg & soda
- Catalogs
- Cereal, food & shoe boxes
- Corrugated & cardboard boxes
- Envelopes
- Junk mail
- Magazines
- Newspapers & inserts
- Paper - copier, printer & shredded
- Paper towel & toilet paper rolls
- Plastic bottles & containers marked #1-7 or HDPE
- Telephone books

Items that CANNOT be recycled

- Ceramics
- Christmas lights
- Coat hangers
- Computers, printers or other office equipment
- Electric cords
- Garden hoses
- Glass cookware/bakeware
- Household items - cooking pots & pans, toasters, etc.
- Light bulbs - incandescent or fluorescent
- Mirrors
- Plastic bags
- Plastics - unnumbered or without recycle symbol
- Porcelain
- Styrofoam - egg cartons, food containers or packing material
- Window or auto glass



Helpful recycling tips

- > Please do NOT place any recyclables in plastic bags.
- > Please remove labels & plastic rings when possible.
- > Separating newspapers is not required, but newspapers can be placed in brown paper bags (no plastic bags, please).
- > If your recycle bin is full, put excess recyclables into brown paper bags.
- > Plastic bags and Styrofoam containers can be recycled at local grocery stores with designated recycling bins.
- > Fluorescent light bulbs can be recycled at a major home improvement store.
- > Place yard waste at curb for the scheduled Wednesday pick up only. Please use a cart or can for loose cuttings, avoid using plastic bags. Paper yard waste bags are available at local hardware stores.
- > Computers, monitors, electronics, etc., can be recycled at the Orange County Landfill. For more information, please call 407-836-6600.
